3. Recommendation of the Evaluation Committee to the Board

EDGC/EJDGC: 1. Choice Estonia 12-19th/20th of August
 2. Choice Norway

EMDGC: 1. Choice Hungary 19th of 26th/27th

- Both bids for EDGC were comparably strong. At the end the difference was, that Estonia had bided already two times very strong. Estonia is the founding member of the EDGF, numbers of spectators will be higher in Estonia.
- Hungary was the only bid for EMDGC. They have to take care for extra stuff. Conditions in the arboretum seem to be great.
- Communication to Estonia by Paul, Hungary by Richard and Norway by Frank.
- Coordinate the publication date earliest Sunday latest Sunday in a week.
- Richard prepares doc with comments and questions for all bidders.

 - Competition manual 1.10 C. "The required Added Cash for a Tier level must be allocated across all Pro divisions based on the percentage of entry fees brought into the overall Pro portion of the event by each division. Added cash above the minimum may be allocated at the TD's discretion."
